

## Job Posting: Full-Time Community Support Specialist (Columbus, Ohio)

DSC is looking for a full-time Community Support Specialist in the Central (Columbus) region. DSC is a non-profit organization serving the Deaf, Hard of Hearing, and Deafblind communities for over 30 years in Ohio's Central, Northwest, and Southern regions. It is one of the longest-standing and largest Community Centers for the Deaf in Ohio.

**Qualifications:** A Bachelor's degree in Human Services is preferred but not mandatory. However, the candidate must be able to communicate with individuals who use sign language fluently. Experience in providing advocacy services related to accessing the community, understanding social service agencies, and being aware of public services is preferred. The candidate should also have experience in working with individuals of all ages. An in-depth understanding of deafness, deaf-blindness, and deaf culture is necessary. The candidate must possess a valid driver's license and a vehicle. They should have flexible time availability based on community needs. The position is contingent on background and reference checks.

## Requirements:

- Must take and pass drug screening and background check.
- Native or fluent in American Sign Language; SPLI Intermediate Plus rating or better
- Intermediate MS Office skills and ability to navigate technology needed to perform duties of the position (Google Drive, Zoom, Facetime, etc.)
- Willing to travel to different counties/areas of Ohio to provide services.
- Excellent interpersonal skills to maintain an effective relationship with referral sources and employers.
- Must have strong decision-making skills.
- Appropriately complete written reports required by the referral sources.
- Complete documentation as needed related to accreditation and referral sources
- Experience in working with contract requirements by local and state agencies
- Self-motivated and able to work both independently and as part of a team

- Provide and monitor Title XX services to ensure qualified Franklin County residents receive assistance.
- Develop and provide services such as ASL tutoring and activities of daily living to deaf individuals who have relocated to Ohio from other countries.
- Provide presentations and workshops to community partners and stakeholders;

- Understanding of SSI, SSDI, food assistance, housing, and other benefits programs
